

## **Tourism in Opolskie Voivodship in 2022**

Concerns tourist accommodation establishments with 10 or more bed places.

Increase in the number of tourists accommodated in tourist accommodation establishments in relation to 2021 r.

In 2022, 336.8 thousand tourists were accommodated in tourist accommodation establishments, for whom 718.0 thousand overnight stays were provided, i.e. more by 40.9% and by 40.2%, respectively compared to 2020. There was also a higher occupancy rate of bed places in tourist accommodation establishments and a higher occupancy rate of rooms in hotels and similar establishments compared to the previous year.

Tourist accommodation establishments in Opolskie Voivodship, as of 31 July 2022, consisted of 120 facilities, i.e. by 0.8% fewer compared to the previous year. Among all the considered accommodation establishments, 102 facilities offered all year round leisure, and their number decreased by 4.7% in relation to 2021. Taking into account the types of tourist accommodation establishments covered by the survey, 69 hotels and similar establishments as well as 51 other accommodation establishments were recorded.


In July 2022 the number of tourist accommodation establishments (including those open all year) decreased compared to July of the previous year

Hotels accounted for 73.9% of all hotels and similar establishments

Among hotels and similar establishments, the most numerous group, as in previous years, were hotels – 51 establishments (by 5.6% fewer compared to 2021). The second group in terms of size were other hotel establishments i.e. those which do not meet the requirements for hotels, motels and boarding houses but provide hotel services (e.g. inns, guest houses) – there were 15 such facilities (by 36.4% more than a year before). Among the other establishments, the most numerous were rooms for rent – 10 (the same as in 2021), then agrotourism lodgings – 7 (the same as in the previous year) as well as hostels – 7 (by 30.0% fewer). In the discussed group of accommodation establishments, other tourist accommodation establishments were also noted, i.e. those which partially served as accommodation facilities for tourists or have not been fully used in accordance with their intended purpose. These have been mainly boarding schools, student dormitories as well as sport and recreational centres.

As of the end of July 2022, similarly to the previous year, the majority of tourist accommodation establishments were located in Nyski Powiat (19.2%). The following powiats were: Opolski (17.5%), the city of Opole (14.2%) and Oleski (9.2%).

At the end of July 2022, 6.8 thousand bed places were prepared in tourist accommodation establishments for the reception of tourists (including 5.8 thousand in establishments open all year), i.e. 4.7% fewer compared to July 2021. Most of bed places – 3.2 thousand, i.e. 46.8%, were offered by hotels. Tourist accommodation establishments density rate measured by the number of bed places per 1 km² accounted for 0.7 (the year before – 0.8).

The scale of changes concerning the number of bed places in relation to 2021 in each type of facilities varied. There was a decrease in the number of bed places, i.a. in hostels (by 23.8%), rooms for rent (by 17.5%) and hotels (by 3.8%). An increase in the number of bed places was recorded for complexes of tourist cottages (by 44.0%), training and recreation centres (by 10.8%) as well as holiday centres (by 10.4%). In the case of camping sites, camping areas and agrotourism lodgings the number of bed places has not changed.

In 2022, the highest number of bed places in tourist accommodation establishments were located in Nyski Powiat (24.9% of the total number of places in the voivodship), then in the city of Opole (17.0%) and Opolski Powiat (14.9%), while the lowest one in powiats: Prudnicki (2.8%), Głubczycki (3.8%) and Namysłowski (4.0%).

Compared to the previous year, in six powiats a decrease in the number of bed places was recorded, among others in Prudnicki (of 31.4%), Brzeski (of 29.7%) and Strzelecki (of 26.8%).

In July 2022 there were fewer bed places than the year before On the other hand, the number of bed places increased in the other six powiats, mainly in Kędzierzyńsko-Kozielski (of 40.3%), Opolski (of 38.2%) as well as Oleski (of 19.1%).

In tourist accommodation establishments, there were on average 72 bed places per 10 thousand population (75 – in 2021). In a cross-section according to powiats, the greatest number of bed places per 10 thousand inhabitants was recorded in Nyski Powiat (132), then in the city of Opole (92) and in Opolski Powiat (85), whereas the smallest in powiats: Prudnicki (37), Brzeski (43) and Krapkowicki (39).

Per 10 thousand population there were 3 bed places fewer in the voivodship than in the previous year



In 2022, 236.8 thousand tourists were accommodated in tourist accommodation establishments, of which in hotels and similar establishments – 272.6 thousand persons, and in other establishments – 64.2 thousand persons. Compared to the previous year, the number of tourists accommodated in tourist accommodation establishments increased by 97.8 thousand persons, i.e. by 40.9% (in 2021 – by 25.7 thousand i.e. by 12.0%). The number of domestic tourists accommodated in tourist accommodation establishments increased by 38.9%, while of foreign tourists by 63.5% in relation to 2021 (the year before the increase by 15.0% as well as decrease by 13.1% were recorded, respectively).

Hotels were the most popular among tourist accommodation establishments. In 2022, the number of persons accommodated in this type of facilities was 235.3 thousand, which accounted for 69.9% of all tourists accommodated in all tourist accommodation establishments. Their number increased by 72.9 thousand persons, i.e. by 44.9% compared to 2021. The majority of hotels' guests chose services offered by three–star establishments. 156.8 thousand persons went for this type of accommodation, i.e. 66.6% of persons accommodated in hotels.

Among guests accommodated in hotels, the majority chose services offered by three-star establishments.

In 2022, 35.0 thousand tourists were accommodated in other hotel establishments, i.e. 10.4% of the total accommodated in tourist accommodation establishments in Opolskie Voivodship. Compared to 2021, their number increased by 16.0 thousand persons, i.e. by 84.4%.

The greatest number of tourists accommodated in tourist accommodation establishments was recorded in the city of Opole – 86.8 thousand people, i.e. 25.8% of the accommodated in total, in Nyski Powiat – 63.4 thousand (18.8%) as well as in Opolski Powiat – 34.7 thousand (10.3%), while the smallest in powiats: Głubczycki – 3.5 thousand (1.3%), Brzeski – 10.1 thousand (3.0%) and Prudnicki – 10.8 thousand (3.2%).


In 2022, tourists who visited Opolskie Voivodship were provided with 718.0 thousand overnight stays in tourist accommodation establishments, i.e. by 205.7 thousand (by 40.2%) more compared to 2021. In hotels and similar establishments, 502.7 thousand overnight stays were provided, i.e. 70.0% of all overnight stays. As in previous years, most overnight stays were provided in hotels – 420.4 thousand, which represented 58.6% of the total overnight stays, on the other hand in the group of other hotel establishments, 69.9 thousand (9.7%) overnight stays were provided. The other establishments accounted for 215.3 thousand overnight stays, i.e. 30.0% of the total number of overnight stays. Compared to 2021, the number of overnight stays in hotels and similar establishments increased by 49.9% and by 21.8% – in other establishments.

The greatest number of overnight stays was provided for tourists in facilities located in Nyski Powiat – 170.3 thousand, i.e. 23.7% of total overnight stays, the city of Opole – 168.7 thousand (23.5%) as well as in Opolski Powiat – 74,8 thousand (10.4%), whereas the smallest in powiats: Głubczycki – 11.4 thousand (1.6%), Prudnicki – 23.2 thousand (3.2%). and Brzeski – 25.2 thousand (3.5%).

In 2022, the total occupancy rate of bed places in all tourist accommodation establishments reached 31.5% and was by 5.8 percentage points higher than the year before. A higher degree of this indicator characterised, among others, holiday centres (43.4%), hotels (34.8%) and training and recreation centres (28.7%). Lower values of the indicator were recorded, among others, for agrotourism lodgings (11.6%), rooms for rent (12.0%) and complexes of tourist cottages (17.0%).

Occupancy rate of bed places in tourist accommodation establishments increased annually from 25.7% to 31,5%


Chart 3. Occupancy rate of bed places in selected tourist accommodation establishments

The occupancy rate of bed places is seasonal, the highest was in the months: July (45.0%), August (44.0%), June (36.4%) as well as in September (35.4%). The lowest occupancy rate of bed places was recorded in January (17.9%), followed by: March (24.6%) and February (25.0%).

The tourist accommodation development rate measured by the number of persons accommodated in tourist accommodation establishments per 1 bed place was at the level of 49 and increased compared to 2021 when it was at 33. The highest place was occupied by Krapkowicki Powiat (the tourist accommodation development rate – 89), then the city of Opole (75) and powiats: Namysłowski and Strzelecki (70 each). The lowest values of this rate were noted in powiats: Głubczycki (17), Brzeski (27) as well as Opolski (34)


In 2022, 316.2 thousand rooms were rented in hotels and similar establishments (i.e. hotels, motels, boarding houses and other hotel establishments) (by 51.4% more than the year before) of which 56.7 thousand to foreign tourists (an increase of 80.8%). Most, i.e. 266.3 thousand rooms were rented in hotels, which accounted for 84.2% of the total number of rooms rented in hotels and similar establishments. The occupancy rate of rooms in hotels and similar establishments amounted to 42.6% and was higher than in the previous year (34.0%), and in hotels – 44.6% (35.3% – the year before).

Tourist traffic intensity rate measured by the number of tourists per 1000 persons accounted to 356 and it increased by 105 in comparison to 2021. The spread of this rate hovered from 104 in Głubczycki Powiat to 685 in the city of Opole.

In 2022 the average duration of a tourist's stay in a tourist accommodation establishment was 2.1 days – the same as the year before while of a foreign tourist – 2.6 days (in 2021 – 2.5). The analysis of the length of stay in individual types of establishments showed that the stay of tourists in hotels and similar establishments (including hotels) was on average 1.8 days. Tourists stayed longer in other tourist accommodation establishments, i.e. 3.4 days, of which the longest in holiday centres and rooms for rent – 4.8 each.

Occupancy rate of rooms in hotels and similar establishments was higher than in 2021 and amounted to 42.6%

In 2022, 32.2 thousand foreign tourists stayed overnight in tourist accommodation establishments, i.e. by 63.5% more than the year before. They accounted for 9.6% of all tourists accommodated in tourist accommodation establishments located in the voivodship. The majority, i.e. 91.0% of foreign tourists accommodated in tourist accommodation establishments stayed in hotels and similar establishments, of which 82.1% in hotels. Compared to 2021, the number of foreign guests in hotels increased by 69.5%


Opolskie Voivodship was most visited by tourists from European countries (94.5% of total foreign tourists), however, their number increased by 61.4% in relation to 2021. Tourists from Asia (2.7%) and North America (1.7%) were ranked further.

Out of all foreign tourists accommodated in tourist accommodation establishments the most numerous were tourists from Germany (39.5% of all foreign visitors accommodated in tourist accommodation establishments) and then from Ukraine (18.2%). In comparison with 2021 the number of tourists from Germany increased by 47.9%, while from Ukraine – by 64.7%. A large group of foreign tourists in 2022 were the ones from Czechia (9.3%) – their number increased by 169.9% in comparison to the previous year.

Most of foreign tourists stayed in hotels

Opolskie Voivodship was most often visited by tourists from Germany and Ukraine Out of other countries the most of the tourists came from the Netherlands (3.6%), Italy (2.6%), Great Britain (2.1%), France (2.0%) and Belgium (1.8%). In comparison to 2021 the number of foreign tourists accommodated in tourist accommodation establishments increased in the case of such countries as: Ireland (fourfold), the USA, Great Britain and Hungary (each threefold). The decrease was noted i.a. in the case of tourists from Turkey (by 32.1%).

In 2022, 82.2 thousand overnight stays were provided for foreign tourists, which represented 11.5% of the total nights provided in tourist accommodation establishments (by 69.5% more than the year before). Most overnight stays for foreign tourists were provided in establishments located in the city of Opole (45.4% of the total number of these overnight stays in the voivodship), and then in powiats: Kędzierzyńsko–Kozielski (13.8%) as well as Nyski (12.8%).

An important element determining the attractiveness of tourist establishments is catering establishments. As of the end of July 2022, there were 112 catering establishments in tourist accommodation establishments, i.e. by 2.8% fewer than in the corresponding period of the previous year.

Half (50.0%) of catering establishments were restaurants. The vast majority, i.e. 91.1% of restaurants were located in hotels and similar establishments, of which 80.4% in hotels. Bars (including cafes) accounted for 29.5% of all catering establishments operating in tourist accommodation establishments, canteens – 11.6%, and catering outlets – 8.9%.
